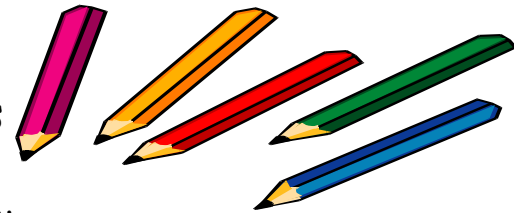


September - Week 2

- We would like to thank you for allowing the children to enter the school yard in the mornings by themselves.
- Please encourage your child to put on and zip/button up their own coat. This helps foster independence.
- This week we are focusing on listening - listen to sounds in the house and outside- what can you hear? what is making the sound? Describe it.
- Revise colours at home.
- This week we are focusing on Nursery rhymes- listening to, joining in and clapping along to them. Sing Nursery Rhymes- Humpty Dumpty, Incy Wincy Spider etc and Action Songs- If your happy and you know it, Heads, shoulders knees and toes etc.
- Sing with your child the songs from September Songs and Rhymes.
- Ask your child to clap out a steady beat to a Nursery rhyme they know.
- Please remember to send all money in a labelled envelope. Dinner money is £13.00 per week and snack is £2.00 per week.
- Label clearly all belongings.
- Newsletters will be sent home weekly.
- Take in homework folders everyday to help children to self manage belongings.
- The children have been given a book bag with a pocket for the weekly notes. Later on they will be taking home Library books, story sheets and reading books. **If you have not sent in the money for a book bag please send £3 as soon as possible.**
- There will be two P.E sessions a week. Your child's teacher will inform you of these days at a later date.
